Ingrid Pustijanac is Associate Professor at the University of Pavia, Department of Musicology and Cultural Heritage (Cremona), where she has been teaching Music Analysis and Compositional techniques and forms of contemporary music. Her writings include a book on György Ligeti and articles about the late 20th-century music with special attention to the spectral music (Gérard Grisey's works and theoretical horizon, in particular), sound studies, improvisation (GINC and experimental music in the Sixties), and mixed music from the perspective of sketch studies and analysis of compositional processes. She is a member of the Editorial Board of Archival Notes, Journal by the Cini Foundation Institute of Music (Venice), member of GREAM (Strasbourg) and the Head of DALM (Dialogic Approach to Living Musics), the research group of the Department of Musicology and Cultural Heritage (Cremona-Pavia).
